Court-Appointed Cross-Border Cost Assessment - Regional Court of Verden, Germany

Court-appointed technical and commercial assessment of the plausibility of cross-border service-related costs in a construction dispute involving works performed in Switzerland. The review covered travel and accommodation expenses, mileage compensation, Swiss labour-related surcharge structures, subsistence expenses and project-related ancillary costs, including analysis of invoices, service records, travel routes, time calculations and cost-allocation methodology.

Court-Appointed Underground Parking Investigation - Switzerland

Large-scale forensic engineering investigation of a multi-building underground parking structure extending approximately 330 metres beneath a residential development. The investigation addressed water ingress, drainage capacity, hydraulic behaviour during rainfall, structural cracking, reinforcement-cover deficiencies, moisture-related deterioration, chloride exposure and long-term durability. Work included repeated inspections, investigations during heavy rainfall, moisture and slope measurements, structural and material investigations, photographic/video evidence preservation and evaluation against Swiss SIA standards.

Court-Appointed Residential Construction Dispute - Liechtenstein

Court-appointed forensic investigation of alleged construction defects, waterproofing deficiencies and corrosion-related durability risks. The dispute concerned terrace waterproofing, drainage concepts, corrosion-sensitive railing components, natural-stone terrace construction and compliance with recognised engineering standards. Work included court-related questions and answers, review of previous expert reports, technical inspections, evaluation of remediation measures and costs, and preparation of formal expert statements.

Independent Technical Investigation - High-Alpine Residential Construction, Switzerland

Independent forensic investigation of a newly constructed high-alpine residential building involving structural timber cracking, building-envelope deficiencies, workmanship and execution deviations, moisture-related durability risks and unresolved structural verification issues. Scope included forensic site inspections, structured evidence preservation, review of structural calculations, snow-load assumptions, execution quality and evaluation against Swiss engineering standards. The assignment included interdisciplinary collaboration with Prof. Felix Wenk, Dipl. Bauing. ETH SIA, OST - Eastern Switzerland University of Applied Sciences.
